Minutes of Executive Committee Meeting dated 18.01.2026

A meeting of the Executive Committee of All Assam Judges Association has been held today, that is, on 18th of January, 2026 (Sunday) at 10:00 AM at the Judicial Officer's Institute, Chandmari, Guwahati. The meeting has been attended by the following members of the Association:

DISCUSSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS:

The Executive Committee discussed the following issues:

1. Adoption of the Constitution of the Association:

The Committee has considered the draft constitution submitted by the Committee for Drafting the Constitution of All Assam Judges Association, headed by Hon'ble Sri Sanjeev Kr Sharma, the then District & Sessions Judge, Kamrup (M) and the views and comments received from the respected members of the Association.

2. Enhancement of age of retirement of Judicial Officers of Assam: The Committee has considered the letter

90/2025/6561/A dated 28.08.2025 received from the Registrar General of the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court. Through that letter the Association was informed that the Hon'ble Administrative Committee of the High Court was of the view that the Assam Judicial Service Association (presently renamed as All Assam Judges Association) may send its representation regarding enhancement of age of superannuation of Judicial Officers of the State of Assam from 60 to 61 years to the Government of Assam for consideration. All the members of the Executive Committee have concurred that a proper representation should be filed before the L.R. cum Commissioner and Secretary, Judicial Department in this regard.

3. **Enhancement of percentage of Risk Allowance paid to the Judicial**

Officers of Assam: The Executive Committee has considered the letter No HC.IX-1/2025/960/RG dated 18.12.2025 sent by the Registrar General, Gauhati High Court to the L.R. cum Commissioner and Secretary, Government of Assam, Judicial Department. In that letter a reference was made to the representation dated 10/12/2025 submitted by the All Assam Judges Association before the High Court in this regard. The Hon'ble High Court forwarded the proposal for payment of risk allowance to the Judicial Officers of Assam @30% of basic pay, as demanded by the Association. The Committee members have opined that it will be appropriate to file a representation before the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam in this regard at this stage.

4. **Taking over the newly constructed rooms of the Guest House and**

furnishing the same: Sri Babul Bezbaruah, JE, PWD remained present at the Executive Committee meeting as a special invitee. He appraised the Committee regarding the construction works done so far. The Committee has considered the fact that the newly constructed rooms, office rooms and conference hall have already been handed over by the PWD, Buildings. A requisition for the interiors has also been sent to the Executive Engineer, PWD, Building division, Fancy

Bazar, Guwahati-01. The Committee has expressed the view that a request should be made to the PWD department for submission of the plan and estimate as early as possible. After completion of the interior works, the rooms should be inaugurated and opened for public.

RESOLUTIONS

After a through discussion on all the issues, the Executive Committee has passed the following resolutions:

1. **Resolution No 1:** The Executive Committee has considered the suggestions/comments received from the members and has approved the draft constitution, with necessary modifications. The Committee has also resolved to present the modified draft before the General Body for approval by way of voting. The voting shall be done by online mode and a notification in this regard shall be issued with the approval of the Hon'ble President. The voting link and the date and time of voting shall be mentioned in the notification.
2. **Resolution No 2:** The Executive Committee has resolved to file a representation before the L.R. cum Commissioner and Secretary, Govt. of Assam, Judicial Department regarding enhancement of age of superannuation of Judicial Officers of Assam from 60 years to 61 years, at the earliest.
3. **Resolution No 3:** The Committee has resolved to file a representation before the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam regarding enhancement of percentage of risk allowance paid to the Judicial Officers of Assam, from the present 10% to 30%.
4. **Resolution No 4:** The Executive Committee has resolved to request the Executive Engineer, PWD Building Division for submitting the plan and estimate

for the interior works of the newly constructed rooms in the guest house as early as possible.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks.
